

8th September 2025 THE CRIME IS MINE (2023)

France Cert: 15 102 mins A young actress (Nadia Tereszkiewicz) stands accused of murdering a famous producer; is she really innocent, or is she getting away with murder? "The Crime is Mine" is a breezy comedy-drama set in 1930s Paris. Directed by François Ozon ("Potiche") and starring French movie-acting royalty, including Isabelle Huppert, Fabrice Luchini and André Dussollier.

22nd September 2025 LA CHIMERA (2023)

Italy, France, Switzerland Cert: 15 131 mins Freed from prison, dishevelled archaeologist Arthur (Josh O'Connor) reunites with his wayward gang of tomb-robbers and opportunistic lawbreakers. "La Chimera" is an enchanting historical drama set in 1980s Italy, with sumptuous, award-winning cinematography and production design.

6th October 2025 I'M STILL HERE (2025)

Brazil, France 137 mins Cert: 15 Married to a former politician (Selton Mello) during the military dictatorship in Brazil, Eunice (Fermanda Torres) is pushed to reinvent herself and chart a new course for her family following a violent and demoralising act. "I'm Still Here" is an engrossing true-life drama set in 1970s Rio de Janeiro. Directed by Walter Salles ("The Motorcycle Diaries"), understated performances underpin a meditative, heartfelt reflection on absence.

27th October 2025 CONCLAVE (2024)

UK, USA 120 mins Cert: 12A Given the task of leading one of the world's most secretive and ancient events, electing a new Pope, Cardinal Lawrence (Ralph Fiennes) lands in the centre of a web of intrigue and conspiracy. "Conclave" is a sumptuous and satisfying drama that makes great use of its Vatican setting, winner of the Academy Award for Best Adapted Screenplay and BAFTA for Outstanding British Film.

17th November 2025 FLOW (2024)

Latvia, France, Belgium 84 mins Cert: U After his home is lost to a great flood, Cat seeks refuge on a boat inhabited by other species, and will have to work with them despite their differences. "Flow" is an immersive animated adventure set in realms natural and mystical, brilliantly using cinematic style and evocative soundscapes to express a simple and soulful fable. Winner of the Academy Award for Best Animated Feature.

12th January 2026 SMALL THINGS LIKE THESE (2024)

Ireland, Belgium 98 mins Cert: 12A Devoted father and coal merchant Bill Furlong suspects iniquity at the forbidding local convent and uncovers shocking truths of his own. Adapted from Claire Keegan's Orwell prize-winning novella, "Small Things Like These" is a poignant historical drama set in 1980s Ireland, with a quietly powerful lead performance from actor-producer Cillian Murphy and powerful supporting performance from Emily Watson.

26th January 2026 FOUR DAUGHTERS (2023)

France, Germany, 107 mins Cert: 15 Tunisia. Saudi Arabia

Exploring memories of the radicalisation and disappearance of her two older daughters, Olfa Hamrouni and her younger daughters reconstruct their story to critique ideas of rebellion and sisterhood. "Four Daughters" is a riveting and layered part documentary part docudrama situated in Tunisia. Winner of L'Oeil d'Or at Cannes.

9th February 2026 A REAL PAIN (2024)

Poland, USA
90 mins
Cert: 15
Reunited for a tour through their family heartland to honour their beloved grandmother, old tensions resurface for mismatched American cousins. "A Real Pain" is an emotional buddy comedy set in Poland. Directed and written by Jesse Eisenberg, winner of the BAFTA for Best Original Screenplay and Best Supporting Actor Academy Award for Kieran Culkin.

9th March 2026 THE LAST DANCE (2024)

Hong Kong

126 mins

Cert: 12A

Under pressure of debts, a wedding planner fortuitously becomes a successful funeral director, but is challenged by a traditional Taoist priest to prove he can truly care for the deceased. "The Last Dance" is a life-affirming drama set in Hong Kong, winner of multiple Hong Kong Film Awards for screenplay, acting and music.

30th March 2026 HARD TRUTHS (2024)

UK, Spain 97 mins Cert: 12A Confrontational, depressed and anxious, Mother's Day looms for Pansy and her family. "Hard Truths" is a tragicomic drama set in suburban London. Directed by Mike Leigh, reuniting with Marianne Jean-Baptiste and Michele Austin ("Secrets and Lies") on form with another superbly-acted unflinching character-study.

13th April 2026 THE COUNT OF MONTE CRISTO (2024)

France 178 mins Cert: 12A Wrongfully imprisoned for state treason, Edmond Dantès (Pierre Niney) plots, schemes and scrupulously machinates to exact revenge on the men who betrayed him. Adapted from Dumas' enduring novel, "The Count of Monte Cristo" is a swashbuckling adventure set in 19th Century France, with adrenaline-boosting drama, cinematography and score.

11th May 2026 DIDI (2024)

USA 94 mins Cert: 15 In the last days of summer break before starting high school, an impressionable Taiwanese-American boy learns what his family can't teach him: how to skate, how to flirt and how to love your mum. "Didi" is an intricately observed, millennial coming-of-age drama set in 2008 California.
